3. The terms of reference of the Task Force shall be as follows:
    - 3.1 Review the existing legislations and schemes, both at the Central and State levels, for providing social security to workers in the unorganised sector;

- 3.2. Examine the prevailing social security system in those States where there is a higher coverage of workers under different social security arrangements (e.g. Kerala, Tamil Nadu and any other) with a view to draw appropriate lessons for designing a comprehensive social security system for the whole country;
- 3.3 Examine the best practices in social security arrangements in the non-government sector with a view to draw appropriate lessons for designing a comprehensive social security system for the whole country;
- 3.4. Draft a comprehensive social security system for workers in the unorganised sector;
- 3.5 Quantify the financial implications of such a comprehensive social security system and suggest the modalities of financing it.
- 4 The Chairman of the Group may co-opt any other person as Member of the Group.
- 5 The Chairman may invite specialists to particular meetings of the Special Group.
- 6 The Group shall submit its draft report by September, 2005 and final report by March, 2006.
7. The expenses towards TA/DA of the official members of the Task Force shall be met by the Government Departments/Institutions to which they belong. The TA/DA of non-official Members and invitees to meetings will be paid by NCEUS as admissible to Grade I Officers of the Government of India.
